Calgary made its debut in 2020 on the CBRE's North American Tech Talent ranking, proving our ability to attract and grow tech talent. More than 5,500 full-time employees are supported by the digital media sector in Calgary (Nordicity, 2018). Post-secondary institutions are developing digital media programs to support the growth of top talent, and to help fill spaces in our growing tech and digital media ecosystem, with an increase of tech talent program completions of 300 per cent since 2018.
